INTEGRATED LAND MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (ILMIS) PROJECT

July 2016 – July 2018

The Ministry of Lands, Housing and Human Settlements Development (MLHSD) in conjunction with the consortium IGN FI/IGN/FIT Conseil/Memoris lead by IGN FI (The French National Institute of Geographical and Forestry Information) is now implementing a pilot initiative for The Design, Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Integrated Land Management Information System (ILMIS). The General Objective of the initiative is to contribute to the land tenure security, improving the security and reliability of land transactions by establishment of efficient and reliable land information system providing affordable, secure and reliable land administration services for the customers and improving public confidence in the land administration services. The project will fully integrate land administration, land registration and surveying, and will support the process of transforming land records and maps into digital formats. The pilot project will be implemented in the Dar es Salaam Region including the Dar es Salaam Zone Office and Kinondoni Municipal Council.

The new efficient and reliable land information system established by the project will:

1. Increase land tenure security.
2. Provide affordable, secure and reliable land administration services to the customers.
3. Reduce the time required to check, update and transfer land.
4. Prevent encroachment on wetlands, forests, road reserves and other public land.
5. Improve stewardship of land and natural resources.
6. Help to reduce corruption associated with checks, registration and transfer of titles, and
7. Improve public confidence in the land administration system.

A genuine land title is needed to:

- a) Secure ownership of land to avoid land disputes.
- b) Buy, sell, lease, gift or transfer land on need.
- c) Be provided as security for loans from banks or microfinance institutions, and
- d) Avoid land disputes and conflicts amongst individuals, families and communities.
